

Disaster Preparedness Checklist for Pets



Food & Water

- Keep a week's worth of food and water on hand for each pet
- Store food in airtight, waterproof containers
- Rotate food every 3 months and water every 2 months
- Have a can opener, food and water dishes, and spoon



ID

- Your pets should always have collars and ID tags
- Consider permanent identification with microchips
- Have current photos of your animals
- Keep important veterinary and insurance documents handy



Pet Medications

- Keep a backup supply of your pet's medications (2 week's worth)
- Include a list of the medications and instructions for each pet
- Have an ice chest ready for pet meds that need to be kept cold



Cleaning Supplies

- A week's worth of litter, litter box, and scoop for cats
- Plastic bags and/or scoop for dogs
- Extra paper towels and disinfectant
